

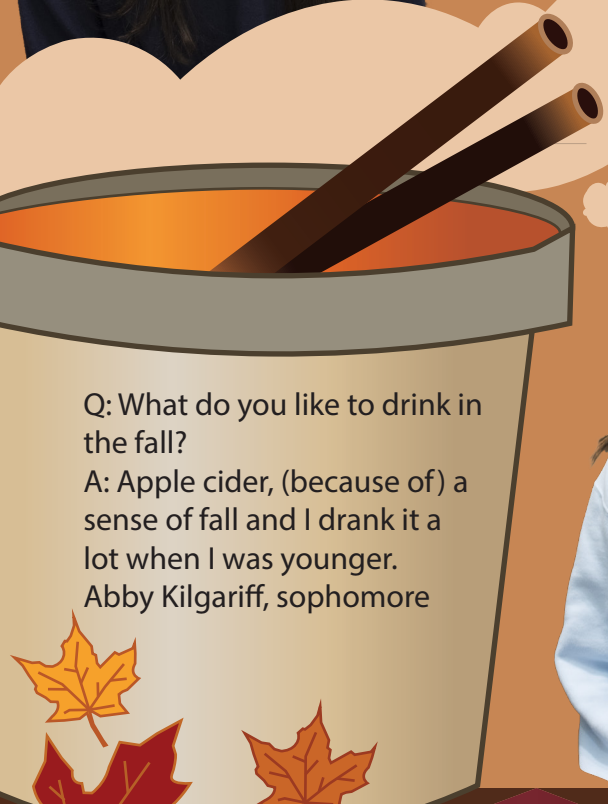

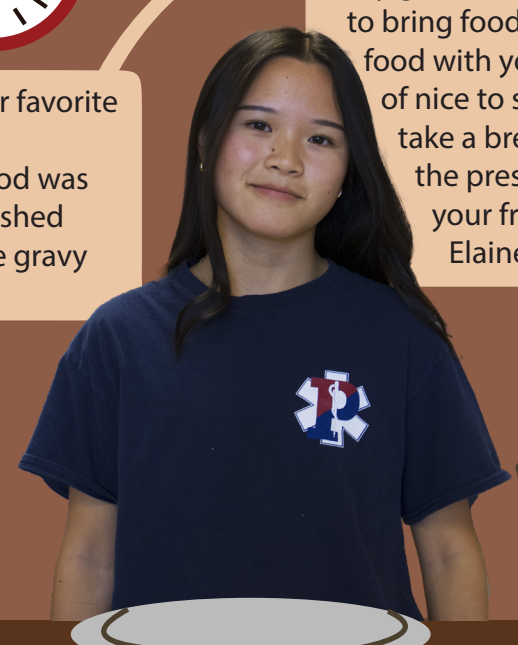


# FRIENDSGIVING
